2004 ANNUAL REPORT ON ACTIVITIES

As our official Centurion year finished on 30 June, it is our pleasant duty to report on the activities that have taken place during the last 12 months and to reflect on the current state of the club and its continuing growth.

The 2003/2004 year has, as usual, been full of activity. Some of the highs included:

- Peter Bennett representing us with distinction in the 2nd Malaysian International 24 Hour event in August 2003.
- Carol Baird making a successful transition from ultra walking to ultra running and immediately setting new Masters standards in her age division.
- Stan Miskin walking an incredible 482 km in the 2003 Colac 6 Day race – at 78 years of age!
- A number of our Victorian based members successfully participating in the Ballarat Ekiden relay in November 2003.
- Spearheading a move to add annual Australian Federation of Race Walking Clubs 100 km Championships for men and women. The inaugural championships will be held in Coburg in April 2005.
- The setting up of Masters Records for the following ultra distance milestones – 50 miles, 12 hours, 100 km, 100 miles and 24 hours. These have been retrospectively awarded and will now be maintained and overseen by the Australian Centurions.
- The successful co-hosting of the Coburg 24 Hour event in April 2004. Two new centurions completed 100 miles

TREASURER'S REPORT FOR YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2004

The Australian Centurions have been able to balance income and expenditure due mainly to the generous support of members and supporters.

Expenses incurred in helping run the 2004 Coburg 24 Hour event were again within budget.

- ♣ Entry fees for the walkers went to the Coburg Harriers to help defray their costs. Hence we received no direct income from this event but in return our costs were considerably reduced – a balance that continues to work in our favour.
- ♣ A Centurion tee-shirt was given to each participant in the walk and certificates and Centurion medallions or silver or bronze medals were awarded to all walkers. Add to that the cost incurred in updating the Honour Board and awarding a replica of the Jack Webber Trophy and the overall cost to the club of this event for the year was \$772.60. Such costs are a year to year proposition, depending on existing stocks.

The club newsletter and administration continue to pay their own way. 21 members each paid a photocopying/postage fee of either \$12 (Australian based) or \$18 (overseas) to continue to receive the newsletter in hardcopy form. We continue to subsidise the cost of sending copies of the newsletter to representatives of the other Centurion clubs and to club members who make large donations. All other members and supporters receive the newsletter by email, at zero cost to the club.

Thank you once again to everyone who generously donated funds to keep the club solvent throughout the year. Since we have no formal subscription rate, this continues to be our main source of income. This financial year, donations totalled \$823.90. A total of 16 members (40% of us) and 1 supporter made donations, each according to his/her ability.

With our financial year now changing from July-June to January-December, members will be asked only once each year for a financial donation towards club expenses. That call will be delayed until January 2005, at which time we shall ask each to contribute, at whatever level you deem appropriate.
