NEWS ON OUR MEMBERS

Rudy Schoors (C 55) and Caroline Mestdagh (C 56) were in action in one of their regular December walking fixtures in Europe. Rudy explains

We walked this weekend the traditional Houffalize to Plombières 110 km walk. Sue Clemens was also one of the participants. The conditions were, as always, pretty hard. Lots of rains during the first seven hours. The road conditions were good on the main tracks but on the small paths it was very icy and slippery because of the snow and frost of the last week. So the combination of rain, ice and mud on that small tracks caused issues for a lot of walkers. One of them, the famous Duth walker Annie van der Meer, broke her ankle. The diagnosis at the hospital was a tough one: an operation and long revalidation. After this the rest of the group continued for the second part. Of course it was not the same atmosphere. It stopped raining and even the sun was shining during the last hours.

I had a phone call in December from Ellwyn Miskin to tell us that **Stan Miskin (C 23)** had suffered a stroke and was recovering in the Dandenong Hospital. The good news is that Stan has returned home and has started the long road to recovery. That being the case, we were very excited to see Ellwyn and Stan at our recent Centurion AGM. Stan is now 87 years old and has had a series of health setbacks over the last couple of years but he is not one to ever lay down and complain. He has long outlived the doctors' prognosis when his prostate cancer returned some years ago in a very aggressive form. He bypassed the normal chemo treatment (he said to me at the time that the treatment was much worse than the complaint!) and he has continued to hold it at bay with a lifestyle of fitness and walking and a mental outlook that remains uniformly positive. In fact, Eddy is in the same M45 division and reached the 100 mile mark before Rudy. Further, his 100km and 12 Hour splits were also M45 All-Comers records. 2012 GORDON SMITH MEMORIAL AWARD

Our Australian Centurions have now completed their voting to decide the winner of the 2012 Gordon Smith Memorial Award. This annual award, named after Australian Centurion Number 1, is awarded for the **Best Australian Ultra Distance Walking Performance of the Year**.

Previous winners are 2005 Deryck Skinner (C 51)

2006 Stan Miskin (C 23) 2007 Terry O'Neill (C 18) 2008 Deryck Skinner (C 51) 2009 Peter Bennett (C 24) 2010 Peter Bennett (C 24) 2011 Michelle Thompson (C 58)

This year, we had three absolutely fantastic nominations (see the last newsletter for further details) and I am very pleased to announce that our winner is **Barry Loveday (C 62)**. Barry tried himself out in the Caboolture 48 Hour walk at the end of July (his first ever walking race), finishing second overall against the runners with 283.500km, the longest distance ever walked in Australia and some 3 km further than Peter Bennett's current Australian record. Along the way, he covered 163 km in the first 24 Hours to become Australian Centurion number 62. It was an amazing debut performance. Barry's splits read just so impressively for someone doing his first ever ultra walk event
