## CABOOLTURE DUSK TO DAWN 12 HOUR ENDURANCE EVENT, 8-9 FEBRUARY 2014

A number of Victorians travelled to the annual Caboolture Dusk to Dawn 12 Hour Endurance event which was held once again on the 500m gravel road loop within the Caboolture Historical Village on the Sunshine Coast in Queensland (see <a href="http://geoffsruns.com">http://geoffsruns.com</a>) on the weekend of 809 February. The surface is not the best so it is not the sort of event which optimises the chance of a good time but that didn't stop around 250 entrants in events ranging from the classic half marathon right through to the 12 Hour run/walk.

The Victorian walkers, along with local Queenslander Peter Bennett, were all entered in the 12 Hour event which started at 6PM on the Saturday evening (hence the name 'Dusk to Dawn') and went throughout the night. ## COBURG 6 HOUR TRACK CHAMPIONSHIPS, COBURG, SUNDAY 23 FEBRUARY

I was at the Harold Stevens Reserve in Coburg on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> February for the annual Coburg 6 Hour Track Championships where a full field of 45 competitors (36 runners and 9 walkers) toed the line for the 6AM start time. Conditions were good early on but it was hot and sunny in the second half of the event. Centurion members **Michelle Thompson (C 58) and Terry O'Neill (C 18)** took the lead from the gun and were never headed. Michelle was the best overall with her distance of 55.731km only about 100m below her Australian Open record and good enough for a new

W45 Australian best. Terry's distance of 53.786km set a new Australian M55 best and was not far outside his best from years past. Karyn O'Neill (C 45) also produced a great walk with a PB 47.442km as did Steve Jordan (C 56) who was just outside his best with 45.900km. And a special mention to Victorian walker Sandra Howorth who walked a big PB with her distance of 41.338km. The next outing for the ultra walkers will be in the Coburg 24 Hour Carnival in 6 weeks time.

### 8 HEURES DE CHARLY, CHARLY-SUR-MARNE, FRANCE, SUNDAY 16 FEBRUARY

Our intrepid European correspondent Emmanuel Tardi was at Charly-sur-Marne, 100km east of Paris, in mid February for the first of the French long distance walk classics. The start time was 8AM and, after a first lap of 3.650km, subsequent laps of 2.575km were walked, to enable an exact 50km time to be clocked. It was the last opportunity for French walkers to qualify for the French National Championship on March 9<sup>th</sup> and a split time of 6:00 or better was required.

It was a big field with 79 individual walkers and 4 teams on the start line. Eddy Roze made the early pace, but after 90 minutes Fabrice Henry overtook him and took the lead. Alas, nothing is easy in longer races and he was eventually forced to stop with sciatic issues, leaving Eddy to reach the 50km mark first in 4:48, some 14 minutes ahead of André Duterte and 25 minutes in front of Fabien Lombard. Roze went on to win easily with 78.325km from Duterte 75.750km and a fast finishing Philippe Morel 73.175km. In the women's race, 2013 winner Deborah Geimer led early but stopped just after halfway, surrendering the lead and the eventual victory to Dominique Malochet with a distance of 65.460km. There was a special award for 81 year old Jean Pichon (born in Dec 1932) who walked just over 55km with a 50km split of 7:06.

### 24 HEURES DE BOURGES, BOURGES, FRANCE, 1-2 MARCH 2014

Our French correspondent Emmanuel Tardi had a busy time last weekend, travelling by train to the French Youth Indoor champs in Lyon on Saturday and then driving to Bourges on Sunday morning, arriving at dawn to catch the final 7 hours of the 24 Heures de Rouen.

Held on the traditional Circuit des Rives d'Auron, the first lap was 540m followed by laps of 2.688km up till the 23 hour mark and finishing with laps of 629m in the final hour - enabling an exact 100km split for all walkers who got that far.

In the men's event, Fabrice Henry immediately took the lead and was a long way ahead by the time he reached 100km (10h31'30). Then came Florian Letourneau 11h45'50, Philippe Thibaux 11h46'10, Dominique Bunel 11h49'35, Philippe Gilles and Emmanuel Lassalle 11h49'50. At that stage, quite a few 200km+ performances looked likely but a cold night took its toll with Letourneau and Bunel both stopped by dawn. Henry also slowed but his lead over Lassalle was too large and he eventually won with an excellent 205.081km ahead of Lassalle 200.740km.

In the women's event, Déborah Geimer led from beginning to end, passing the 100k mark around 12:30 and clocking a final distance of 174.311km. Nicoletta Mizera was holding second before stopping overnight, leaving Sylvie Mason to take 2nd with 165.802km. Emilie Bizard passed Françoise Fabre in the dying hours to take 3rd with 157.099km.


Hello Tim and Lois,

Last weekend our long distance walks started again. We walked near to Antwerp a small place called Bazel (Kruibeke). It's the hometown of Willy Vermeulen. This walk of 100 km is organized by two very passionate walkers. They make this event happen every two years. The pace is between 6 and 8 km/h. It's a marked trail but after thirty km the whole group comes together. You have five hours and forty minutes to get at this point. Fast walkers have to wait here slow ones have to hurry. At point sixty km the same rule. The last forty km you can walk at your own pace direction endpoint. Only one hundred people are allowed to start this walk. At 9 PM eighty eight women and men began the walk this third edition.

It's a well-organized walk: every 7 a 8 km you have drinks and food in open air. At junction 30km and 60km you can have refreshments in a pub or hall. Here you can, if necessary, change clothes and use the toilets. The walk itself was very difficult. Because of the rain during the last weeks the trails were very mud and slippery. The weather was very good: stars were shining during the night and mild temperatures. Only the strong wind was chilly. In the morning we had a small shower of rain. So no complains about these conditions. Around three o'clock we arrived back in Bazel with a bunch of friends with whom we walked this trail together.

One remarkable footnote for the Belgian Centurions, especially for the ladies: for the first time the four Belgian Centurion Ladies walked together on a 100 km walk. On the picture you can see from left to right: Hilde Krols C784, Marth Pemen C1096, Caroline Mestdagh C1061 and Marie-Paule Vandenabeele C1070.
